General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Privacy

This Policy explains how Tony Adcock Limited, "the Company" uses the personal data that it collects from you.

What data does the Company collect?

The Company collects personal data, such as names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers.

How does the Company collect your data?

Data is provided to the Company directly by you, by you communicating with the Company, (for instance by email), or by you responding to marketing communications, (for instance by email).

How does the Company use your data?

How does the Company store your data?

- *Right to erasure* you have the right to request that the Company erase any personal data, under certain circumstances.
- **Right to restrict processing** you have the right to request that the Company restricts processing of your personal data, under certain circumstances.
- *Right to object to processing* you have the right to object to the Company processing your personal data, under certain circumstances.
- **Right to data portability** you have the right to request that the Company transfer your personal data to another company or individual, or directly to you, under certain circumstances.
